

A NOTE FROM PASTOR NATHAN

"I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble.

But take heart! I have overcome the world."

John 16:33 (NIV 1984)

One helpful way to dig into the Bible is by doing a "word study." In a word study we look up every place that a particular word appears so that we can figure out what it means, how it is used, and what it has to do with us. Today, let's look at the Greek word, tharseo (thar-SAY-oh), which appears seven times in the New Testament. Below I quote the Greek word itself (spelling varies by context) rather than an English translation, so that we can hear the term with fresh ears.

Matthew 9:2

Jesus says to a man with paralysis: "Tharsei (THAR-say), son, your sins are forgiven!"

Matthew 9:22

Jesus says to a long-suffering woman: "Tharsei, daughter, your faith has saved you!"

Matthew 14:27 and Mark 6:50

Walking on the lake at night, Jesus calls to his disciples: "Tharseite! (thar-SAY-te) I AM! Do not be afraid!"

Mark 10:49

The crowd encourages a blind beggar whom Jesus is calling: "Tharsei! Rise up! He's calling you!"

John 16:33

Jesus prepares his disciples: "In this world you will have trouble, but tharseite, I have overcome the world!"

Acts 23:11

Jesus exhorts Paul: "Tharsei, for as you testified about me in Jerusalem, so you must also testify in Rome."

Let's try to describe the word without defining it. *Tharseo* is something we do because Jesus has forgiven our sins. It is our response to Jesus' declaration that our faith has saved us. It is the demeanor we possess because Jesus – the Great "I AM" – is with us. It is our countenance because, though others may reject us, Jesus *wants* to spend time with us. It is our posture in a rattling world because we know the One who has overcome that world. It is necessary for obedience because the Lord has more work yet for us to do.

It is Jesus' invitation to all children of God. We might call it confidence, courage, or "taking heart." It is a different way of thinking and living. It opposes the default insecurity, discouragement, and fear which plague human life on earth.

It is a word that we need. We need to hear the lips of Jesus saying to us, "Have confidence! Be courageous! Take heart! I've forgiven you! I've saved you! I'm with you! I'm calling you! I've got more work for you to do! Do not be afraid! I have overcome the world!"

Maybe you are in a downtrodden place as you read this today. Take heart, brothers and sisters! Jesus loves us! He has forgiven us! He is stronger than anything that faces us! He has already won the final victory. And He is with us, today!
