A Note from Pastor Nathan

"For we cannot help speaking about what we have seen and heard." Acts 4:20

That was how Peter and John responded when the authorities told them to stop talking about Jesus. They couldn't stop talking about Jesus! Not after all they had seen Jesus do and who they had found Jesus to be! These early followers of Christ had encountered Him in profound ways, and their all-of-life witness was both contagious and courageous. Their number was growing by the thousands, and they were unable to stop speaking about Jesus Christ, even when the most powerful people in town forbade them from doing so.

During our summer sermon series we have named some of the things in life that we have no trouble talking about. These are our favorite things or people or places that we most cherish or most enjoy or that have most significantly transformed our lives. We witness to what excites us.

If we assess ourselves honestly, we may find that we are more excited about many things than we are about Jesus Christ. In our heads, we know there is nothing more compelling than the King of kings and Lord of lords. But in our hearts, we may hold other things to be more valuable. And as Jesus said, "Out of the overflow of the heart, the mouth speaks" (Luke 6:45). That which is important to our hearts will come out in our lives.

"You will be my witnesses" must therefore begin in our hearts. How does a heart get excited about something? Hearts do not get excited by being *told* to be excited. Our hearts get excited when we encounter something meaningful, and find ourselves desiring more of that something. Then, we find ourselves figuring out ways to encounter that something again. We set aside time for that something. We study to learn more about that something. We find others who share joy in that same something and talk with them about that something. We wear clothing and display pictures so that other people will know how much we love that something. We find ways to integrate that something into all of life. We are really quite good at this process and have cultivated a contagious love for many "somethings."

We will not develop into contagious witnesses of Jesus Christ by trying harder to witness more. We will not become more excited about Jesus Christ by trying harder to be excited. Our calling is simply to pursue Jesus. We can pursue Jesus much like we pursue the somethings of the previous paragraph. As we find Him, and find Him greater than anything and everything else, we become increasingly unable to contain our enthusiasm about Him. This Spiritempowered overflow is our witness. "We cannot help speaking about what we have seen and heard."

One other thing must be said about our pursuit of somethings. For our most important somethings, we are willing to set aside all of the other somethings. This is necessary, in order to free up time, space, and energy to pursue the greater something. So also with Christ. We must surrender all of our other somethings to Him in order to find Him. "For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will save it" (Luke 9:24).

So our prayer is that the Lord would help us to pursue Him. We pray that He would help us to set aside anything that is hindering our pursuit. We pray that He would overwhelm us with Himself, that we might be so very captivated by Jesus Christ that we cannot help but declare Him to the world around us. Lord, help us to be your witnesses!
