DAYCARE NEWS

All employees at Bright Beginnings are required to have first aid, CPR, and universal precautions training; state and federal criminal history background checks; fingerprinting; drug tests; TB tests and physicals. We are also required to have a minimum of 15 hours of child care related training per year. We passed our recent inspections with flying colors! © Our staff is awesome!!!

We conduct monthly fire drills, as well as tornado and earth quake drills.

The children enjoy calling, praying for and sending cards to people who are sick. (Please let us know if you have prayer requests or would like calls or know of someone who would.) We send coloring pictures to Nursing Homes. It is wonderful to see the children learning to Pray and show God's love.

Pastor Nathan visits us once a week to read to and talk with the children. They sure look forward to his visits, bible stories and talks.

This summer, we took field trips to the Bloomfield Park and Library, Dairy Queen, Linton Putt Putt and Park, McDonalds, and Linton Pool.

Now that school is back in session, we have a daily devotion and pray time with the school aged children before the bus comes for them.

Things are going well and we are continuing to teach our children about our Lord and the children are continuing to teach us also.

We could use some help on our toddler playground. There are many days that we cannot use the playground because it is "too muddy, weeds too high, ground bees etc." We would like to have a cement area, grass area and sand area. We also need to have some sandboxes made for both play grounds. If you can help with any of these things, please let Ms. Tammy know. Thank you.
