Mark 14:32-38 (adapted from NIV, 1984 ed.)

LEADER: They went to a place called Gethsemane, and Jesus said to his disciples,

PEOPLE: "Sit here while I pray."

L: He took Peter, James and John along with him, and he began to be deeply distressed and troubled.

P: "My soul is overwhelmed with sorrow to the point of death. Stay here and keep watch."

L: Going a little farther, he fell to the ground and prayed that if possible the hour might pass from him.

P: "Abba, Father, everything is possible for you. Take this cup from me. Yet not what I will, but what you will."

L: Then he returned to his disciples and found them sleeping.

P: "Simon, are you asleep? Could you not keep watch for one hour?"

ALL: Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the body is weak."
