# A Note from Pastor Nathan

This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of him.

1 John 5:14-15 (NIV, 1984)

A few nights ago Tiffany and I were getting ready to run some errands while Liz was making dinner. The garage door was already up. As I was buckling Tiffany into her car seat we heard a train whistle. She asked, "Daddy, can we go see the train?"

You might have heard that I like trains. I'm the kind of person who will change my route in order *to* get railroaded. Tiffany and I had gone on similar adventures before, sometimes at my initiative, sometimes at hers. So of course, I said, "yes."

It only took a few minutes to catch up to the train (quite safely, I assure you) and then watch it pass by. As we returned to town, I realized how much I delighted in the whole experience. Tiffany wanted and asked to do the very thing I already wanted to do. At her initiative, we got to enjoy something together that she couldn't have done on her own, something that we probably wouldn't have done if she hadn't asked.

This got me thinking about how much God must love it when we ask for something that He already wants to do:

Lord, I want to be closer to you.

Lord, open my heart to receive what you're saying to me.

Lord, help me to forgive So-and-so who hurt me deeply.

Lord, give me wisdom for this difficult situation.

Lord, give me some new ideas about how I can love my neighbors.

There are thousands more prayers we might pray, but you get the idea. When we pray according to God's will, we invite God to move in directions God wants to move in, and to do things in our lives that we could not do apart from Him. How delighted God must be when we pray for His will to be done, when we humble ourselves and ask Him to make it happen, when we get to participate together with Him in the very things He wants to do. In many cases, it would seem as though God is simply waiting for us to ask.

One of the great mysteries of God is that He chooses to participate with us interactively instead of doing everything independently. God must enjoy working *with* us and *in* us. He often yields, waiting to do things He wants to do until we also desire to do those things with Him. At our initiative, we get to enjoy things together with God that we couldn't have done on our own, and that God might not have done if we hadn't asked.

I wonder what delightful thing we might invite God to do next. I think He's waiting with joyful anticipation.
