A Note from Pastor Nathan

"Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others. Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus..."

Philippians 2:4-5 (NIV, '84)

Children's books can teach us a lot. Liz and I have occasion to read quite a few children's books with Tiffany.

Dr. Seuss has written a book called, *The Sneetches and Other Stories*. One such story is about two Zax: a North-going Zax and a South-going Zax. Each Zax has been traveling in his respective direction all of his life. One day, the two Zax happen to collide on a particular spot of ground. They begin to argue. Each wants to be on his way, but neither Zax can move, not even briefly, to step around the other. As the Southgoing Zax says, "Never budge in the least, not an inch to the west, not an each to the east!"

As a result of this commitment to non-budging, the Zax remain there, face-to-face, for years. A city rises up nearby. A highway system is built over them and around them. But the Zax never move.

The way of the Zax is common in our world (Phil. 2:21)! It is easy to think of examples of people who remind us of the Zax. But it can be uncomfortable to consider just how much "Zax" there might be in you and in me.

We are called to submit to one another out of reverence for Christ (Eph. 4:21). We are called to be servants like our Lord Jesus (John 13:14-17). We are called to look out for the interests of others, not just our own.

What do we do with the gap between our Zax-inclinations and our Christ-like calling? Pray! "Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting" (Psalm 139:23-24, NIV '84).

Holy Spirit, help us to walk in the way of Christ and not in the way of the Zax.
