He also has two degrees from institutions in Scotland: A Master's Degree in Theology from St. Andrews and a PhD in Economics and Ethics from Glasgow.

Pastor Laythan Musgrave – Pastor Musgrave is an avid outdoorsman. Growing up in rural southern Illinois he spent his time fishing, hunting and going to church. In 1997 Laythan gave his life to the Lord and has been ministering ever since. He preaches at Church of the Harvest in Wayne City, runs a hunting outfitting company and is also featured on the Sportsman Channel for his Hallowed Ground bow hunting show. He and his wife, Kristin, had three children: Gracie, Hallie and George Owen.

Dr. Johnnie Blount – Dr. Blount is the founder and CEO of Bridging the Gap Ministries. Johnnie, a native of North Carolina, began ministering in nursing homes at age fifteen. At eighteen, he moved to Kentucky to continue formal education and ministry. He received a Doctorate in 1995 and later started three churches and two Bibles colleges. Today he coaches through his Fanning the Flame program and also conducts numerous services and conferences around the country.
