When I asked him if he told his Dad that is not the way Jesus wants us to act he replied "I forgot." I told him to go talk with the child tell the child he did not like what he was doing and to please stop. He replied ok and away he went. I talked with his Dad later and he admitted that, like many of us with our Children, he had said "just punch him." The very next day Dad called me to apologize. He said when they got in the car last night the child told his Daddy "I am mad at you. The advice you gave me was wrong and that is not the way Jesus wants us to act." Daddy and son had a long discussion and daddy told his son that he was wrong and sorry for telling him to do that. All is good now. Daddy gave me permission to put this in the newsletter because it was a good lesson and he learned a lot from it. It is a good lesson for every parent and what a wonderful world if we could all just talk it out instead of hurting others.

One of my favorite things about working at Bright Beginnings is hearing the things the children say. It can be highly amusing and keeps me laughing.

Here are just a couple:

- A 5 year old little boy came into his classroom and a 4 year old little girl walked up to him and tried to give him a hug. The little boy pushed her away. His Mom said "Give her a hug" and the little girl replied "Yeah! It's Valentine's Day and that means Love!"
- Pastor Nathan was reading to the children about Jesus breaking the bread and pouring the wine and talking about washing away our sins and going to Heaven. When he got to the part where they sang their favorite song and walked to their favorite place, an Olive garden, one of our 5 year olds got excited and said "The place where you go to get Italian food?"

Praying about Interfaces

All relationships happen in the context of interfaces. Interfaces are the different connecting points we have with God, with other Christians, and with our neighbors who may not know Christ. The sermon series we completed in February challenged us to think about these interfaces. The whole point is, we want to connect better, more deeply, more effectively, with God and with others. This is in obedience to Jesus' great commandment.

So I invite you to take some time to pray about these things...

How am I connecting with God in my life right now?

What aspect of my relationship with God is the strongest right now? Why is that?

Is there some dimension of my relationship with God that is lacking? Why is that?

Is there some new interface – or some fresh way of doing an old interface – that God is calling me to pursue?

Is there anything in my life that needs to be eliminated or tamed so that I can connect with God more fully?

How am I connecting with my brothers and sisters in Christ right now?

With which other Christian(s) do I have the deepest and best relationship(s)? Why is that?

Is there some new way of connecting that I am longing for with other Christians? What is it?

Is God calling me to start some new (or maybe join some already-existing) way of connecting with other Christians? If so, what is it? Who might share this passion and join with me?

How am I living my life around other Christians? Am I spurring others on toward love and good deeds?

How am I connecting with my non-Christian neighbors right now?

Do I have a relationship of depth with any non-Christian(s)?

Is there a non-Christian whom I know only casually that God is calling me to get to know more deeply?

Do I require non-Christians to meet me only in interfaces that are comfortable/natural to me, or am I willing to go and meet with them in interfaces that might not be so comfortable/natural?

Am I willing to be vulnerable in the ways Jesus is calling me to be vulnerable for the sake of His kingdom?

Pray about these things! I am interested in knowing what the Holy Spirit is speaking to you. I trust the Lord is preparing to open new horizons in our lives and in our church. So this is exciting! He makes all things new.
