As I am sitting here in my office praying about what to write to you this month, the Lord brings my attention to a bulletin insert hanging on the wall from the bottom of my calendar. There is a list of nine things we prayed for two years ago during our 150th Anniversary Celebration in September of 2019. We prayed for the next 150 years of ministry for FBC Bloomfield. I need reminders to pray, and perhaps you do as well. So, I'm including those prayer requests again here for our benefit, that we might continually pray these things together...
