A NOTE FROM PASTOR NATHAN

The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

John 1:14 (NIV 1984)

Christmas is the story of how Jesus came into our world. God moved into our neighborhood to do life with us. He came to personally share in our experiences. He came to die and rise again. He came to save us. Jesus did all of this because He loves us. His coming has changed the world and our lives! It is worth telling – and singing – again and again!

We have heard and sung the Christmas story so often that we probably know it pretty well by now. (We even know parts of the story that aren't actually in the story! There is no innkeeper or donkey in Luke 2. Matthew doesn't tell us how many magi there were or what their mode of transportation was.) Most of us who have been hanging around church for a long time could tell the basic details of the story. We know how Jesus came into the world.

How did Jesus come into your heart? What is the story of Jesus coming into you? Your encounter with Jesus may have started suddenly – you might remember a particular day or season of life during which your relationship with Jesus began. Or, your journey with Jesus may have begun so gradually that you cannot point to a date on the calendar, but you could tell me of the impact He has made in your life.

I encourage you to think about your journey with Jesus. Why did you start following Jesus? Why have you continued to follow Jesus? What have you learned along the way? How has Jesus changed you?

Take some time to think about your answers to those questions. Refamiliarize yourself with the reasons why you started following Jesus and why you've kept at it over the years. Be ready to share your story. It doesn't have to be fancy. Just tell the truth. "You will be my witnesses," Jesus tells us. Let's be ready to share Who we are following, and why.

(If you really get excited about this newsletter article I suppose you could put your story with Jesus to music! Pick a Christmas tune and start singing your own words along with it – the story of how Jesus came into your life. If you actually do this, I'd love to hear it! When we put stories to music, we remember them better.)

It is also possible that you've not yet personally responded to Jesus' coming into the world by inviting Him into your heart. If that is the case, I'd encourage you, today is a great day to do that! Why not welcome Him in? Why not take Him up on His offer, and receive the gifts He desires to give you? If you're not sure where to get started with this, I would love to talk and pray with you about it.

This Christmas, as we think about Jesus coming into the world, let's reflect on His coming into our hearts. And "let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe" (Heb. 12:28).
