Bloomfield First Baptist Memorial Scholarship Application

This scholarship is to be used for tuition assistance and is available to members of Bloomfield First Baptist Church who are active in the church. To be eligible, a minimum of 60% attendance in church activities during the past year is required. The maximum value of the scholarship is \$500.00 (see note below) and available to all members who have been accepted at a college, university or trade school. It is renewable for up to four years of undergraduate studies. To be eligible for renewal for a member who resides outside of the Bloomfield FBC area, attendance and participation at a local church as well as attendance and participation in FBC activities while on holidays, visits, breaks, and summer that show commitment to FBC, will be taken into consideration by the FBC Church Council.

The actual amount of the individual scholarships is dependent on available cash in the Scholarship Fund. Funding permitting, \$500 scholarships will be awarded. If the number of applicants is such that \$500 scholarships would create a negative balance in the Scholarship Fund, the actual scholarship award value will be the amount in the Fund divided by the number of applicants.

The application is available on the library counter, or can be emailed to you. Please return the application to the church office by April 1, 2024 with a short essay (150 – 250 words) describing your plans for the future and why you would like this scholarship.


