**Rev. Joshua Sullivan** – Joshua and his wife, Christy, have been the directors of Be Real Ministries since 1998. Be Real Ministries is an evangelistic ministry reaching out to schools, churches and communities. Residing in Hernando, Mississippi, the Sullivan family travel all across the United States ministering at conferences, events and camps for teens and adults. Joshua and Christy have three children: Faith, Hope and Justice.

**Dr. Kevin Brown** – Dr. Brown is a professor of Business at Asbury University. Originally from Louisville, Kentucky, Dr. Brown has taught business the past five years. Prior to that Kevin worked for a decade at Wells Fargo Bank. Dr. Brown has an undergraduate degree and an MBA from the University of Indianapolis. He also has two degrees from institutions in Scotland: A Master's Degree in Theology from St. Andrews and a PhD in Economics and Ethics from Glasgow.

In 1997 Laythan gave his life to the Lord and has been ministering ever since. Today he coaches through his Fanning the Flame program and also conducts numerous services and conferences around the country.
