Open Arms Ministry, located across from the 4H fair grounds is seeking donations to help them replace 23 year old new carpet for a hallway in one of their larger homes. The Miriam Home is the facility where many girls with numerous problems in their life have found God along with a sense of direction in their life. Total cost of the project is estimated at \$14,800. They have divided the hallway into squares. It takes 3,000 squares of carpet and includes vinyl for the kitchen and laundry room to complete the project. Here are some giving opportunities:
