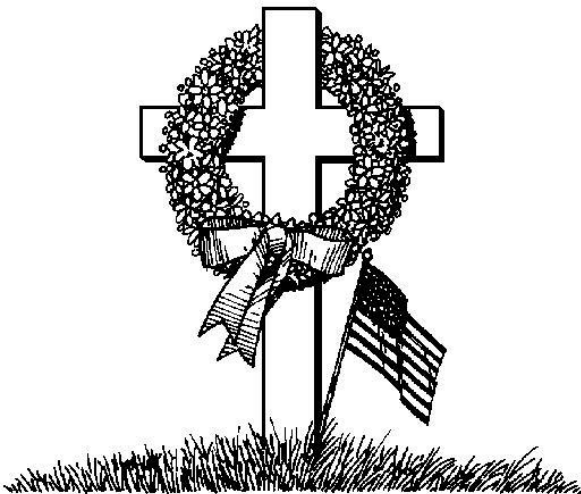
Save the Date(s)
