Congregational Meeting on August 11

There will be a vote at the next Congregational meeting to change the wording in the **Personnel, Policies, and Procedures Handbook** that describes the position of Director of the Bright Beginnings Daycare Ministry of the First Baptist Church Bloomfield. We will strike the phrase "This is a salaried position." Due to a change in the State's minimum requirement for salaries to qualify as exempt for overtime pay, the Director's position is now hourly. This allows us to accurately track the overtime we'll be required to pay. We will add the wording "The record of hours worked will be submitted weekly to the Bookkeeper." These changes will take place under **1.4.6 Bright Beginnings Daycare Director**.

Preschool Scholarship Fund

We are including all the daycare kids in our morning preschool and some children attend daycare on a voucher program, which does not cover Preschool. Monthly Preschool costs are \$50 for the 2 day class, or \$75 for the 3 day class for our daycare children.
