COOKS IN THE BELFRY

Recipe for: Blueberry Zucchini Bread

Ingredients:

3 eggs

1 c. vegetable oil

3 tsp. vanilla extract

2 ½ c. white sugar

2 c. shredded zucchini

3 c. all-purpose flour

1 tsp. salt

1 tsp. baking powder

½ tsp. baking soda

1 Tbsp. ground cinnamon

1 pt fresh blueberries

Directions:

Pre-heat oven to 350 deg. Lightly grease 2 loaf pans.

In a large bowl, beat together the eggs, oil, vanilla, and sugar.

Fold in the zucchini.

Beat in the flour, salt, baking powder, baking soda, and cinnamon.

Gently fold in the blueberries.

Transfer to loaf pans.

Bake 1 hour and 10 minutes in preheated oven, or until a knife inserted

in the center of loaf comes out clean. Begin checking at 1 hour.

Cool 20 min. in pans, then turn out onto wire racks to cool.

Recipe for: Zucchini Surprise

Ingredients:

3 c. thin sliced zucchini

½ c. chopped onion

1 c. bisquick

½ c. Crisco

4 eggs beaten

½ c. parmesan cheese

2 Tbsp. parsley

½ tsp. salt

½ tsp. oregano

½ tsp. oregano

½ tsp. seasoned salt

Clove garlic or dash of garlic powder

dash of pepper

Directions:

Mix all together.

Put in greased jelly roll pan (11" x 15" x 1" or cookie sheet with

edge).

Bake 25 min. at 350 deg.

Note: I add sausage or hamburger. Additional cheeses are good tool.

FOOD PANTRY NEWS

The food pantry served 94 families in June and 68 so far in July. Due to Vacation Bible School going on the pantry was not open on Tuesday, July 25th in the evening hours. It will resume being open on Tuesday evening August 1st. We received 67 1/2 dozen eggs from Rebuilt Ministries. The eggs were in flats and many people donated cartons for the eggs to be transferred to. Produce from Tooger and Charlotte Smith, Master Gardeners, and others have been much appreciated by the families receiving them. The pantry is always in need of cereal, any kind of meat, tomato juice or apple juice and just about anything a person wanted to donate. Each week more new families need help!

A NOTE FROM PASTOR NATHAN

And God placed all things under his feet and appointed him to be head over everything for the church, which is his body, the fullness of him who fills everything in every way.

And in him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit.



I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.

Ephesians 1:22-23; 2:22; 3:16-19 (N/V, '84)

This month we begin a sermon series on Paul's letter to the Ephesians. I've given this series the title, "Full." We'll see the language of "full" and "filling" throughout the letter. The God who fills all things wants to fill us with Jesus himself, by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Our prayer is, "We want to be full of King Jesus!"

Why do you desire Jesus? What is it about Him that draws you to Him? What have you seen Him do? What do you long for Him to do? Why does being full of Jesus sound like a good thing to you?

What else are you full of? What is dominating your heart or mind or calendar or home, maybe that even gets in the way of being filled Jesus? Does your love for Jesus compel you to make some other change so as to abide more fully in Him?

These are tough questions. My prayer is that this journey through Ephesians would not simply be something to do on Sunday mornings for a few months, but that we would be shaped by our King in new and exciting ways. What new things does Jesus want to do in us and through us during this season together?

In this newsletter, you'll find a recommended reading schedule for Ephesians (these will also be available at the church if you'd like a physical copy). As it stands, it would take you through the letter three times. If you use it that way, I encourage you to try using a different translation of the Bible on each journey. The Holy Spirit may speak in a fresh way to you through a translation you're not as familiar with.

But don't make the reading guide into a box. As a preacher once said, "We don't read the Bible to finish; we read the Bible to change." The guide is just a template, just a starting point. The Holy Spirit likes to stop me when I'm reading a passage of scripture or going over a passage I've memorized. I want to get to the end; the Spirit wants me to stop and reflect. So, I'd encourage you to be willing to do that as you read Ephesians.

What is the Lord speaking to you as we study this letter together? This isn't a "You Asked for It" sermon series, but it is still an opportunity for us to talk together about your questions and about what the Holy Spirit is doing in our hearts. I invite those kinds of conversations with you as always.


Thank you for letting me preach and teach here. I'm really having a lot of fun. You're a fantastic church family and I'm excited for what the Lord is going to do among us next.


