



Here are some ideas for any leftover zucchini from your garden. All of this month's recipes are taken from the FBC 125^{th} Anniversary Cookbook.

Zucchini Relish Submitted by Debra Hudson

10 c. ground zucchini

5 1/2 tsp. salt

4 c. chopped onion

Stir together, let set overnight and drain.

2 bell peppers (green & red)

1 tsp. dry mustard

2 1/2 c. vinegar

1 heaping tsp. celery seed

1/2 tsp. black pepper

1 tsp. turmeric powder

5 c. sugar

1 tsp. nutmea

1 heaping tsp. cornstarch

Mix and cook 30 minutes. Put in hot jars and seal.

Zucchini Bake

2 to 3 c. chopped zucchini 1/2 lb. sausage browned

1/2 c. milk 2 eggs

1 c. grated Cheddar 34 c. cracker crumbs or Colby cheese 44 c. chopped onion

Boil zucchini in water until tender. Drain well. Mix all ingredients together and bake at 350° for 30-45 minutes.

1 Large zucchini (cucumber size)

1 large tomato, chopped

1/2 green pepper, chopped

3 Tbs. butter

1 small onion, chopped

1/2 c. grated Parmesan cheese

Stir and cook vegetables in butter over high until tender, about 15 minutes. Top with cheese before serving.

FROM THE BLESSING BOX MINISTRY



WORLD MISSION SILENT AUCTION REMINDER



A NOTE FROM PASTOR NATHAN

Behold, I am coming soon! My reward is with me, and I will give to everyone according to what he has done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End.

Revelation 22:12-13 (NIV)



Thirteen years ago, when Liz and I were living in Logansport, Indiana, I learned to my dismay that a steam locomotive had rolled through town without my knowing it. Nickel Plate Road #765, restored and operated by the Fort Wayne Railroad Historical Society, had steamed its way west to a festival in the Quad Cities of Illinois and Iowa. I had missed it.

Then came the good news: it would return to Fort Wayne by reverse route, spending the night in Logansport. A second coming! Naturally, I learned all that I could about 765's return, to ensure I would be in the right place at the right time.

This month, Union Pacific "Big Boy" #4014, the largest operating steam locomotive on earth, is touring the country, a round trip from Cheyenne, Wyoming, through Chicago, St. Louis, Dallas, Houston, Fort Worth, Kansas City, and Denver. It's that Chicago-St. Louis leg that caught my attention.

Naturally, I have learned all that I can about 4014's journey. My phone now alerts me every time the locomotive moves or stops. (This has proven to be a bit much, so I have disabled notifications until the day I attempt to see it.) I have studied maps to identify driving routes and parking lots that might position me to see the locomotive, maybe two or three times if all circumstances cooperate.

I'm seriously like a little kid about this.

Have you heard that Jesus is coming again? The King will pay us a royal visit! He will appear again and bring with Him all who have died believing in Him. The dead in Christ will be raised, and then we who are living! When we are revealed in our new bodies, all creation will be set free! God is making all things new! He will wipe every tear from our eyes!

Of course, He will also judge the world and punish all unrepentant evil. The biblical authors urge repentance in preparation for the coming of the Lord. But this, too, is good news. Evil will run out of time! King Jesus has prevailed!

Imagine that. The world set right. The wicked finally held to account. The faithful vindicated and set free. No more death, crying, mourning, or pain. No more war or famine. Everything will forever be the way God intended it to be. All of these hopes and dreams will be finally and fully realized when King Jesus visits again.

I wonder if you're excited?

This calls for prayerful watchfulness and readiness. This calls for compassionate, sincere witness. This calls for diligent, faithful preparation. Not from a people who are scared to death, but from a people who are in awe of the King's grace.

I wonder if we are ready.

When I think about the lengths to which I will go in order to prepare for short-lived things – a glimpse of a locomotive, an afternoon at the ballpark, a or a much-needed family vacation – I am invited to evaluate my readiness for the coming of the King, the event which finally changes everything forever.



I have spent several weeks learning a great deal about a steam locomotive. We have the opportunity to devote a lifetime to learning about our King.
