

# **DELIRIS AND MOISE CARRIÓN-JOSEPH**

Deliris and Moise Carrión-Joseph serve among Haitian, Central American, and African migrants who have made their new home in Tijuana, Mexico. Moise is a business entrepreneur, and Deliris is a pastor and occupational therapist. They serve with the Baja Regional Baptist Convention "Dios con nosotros" and "Vision de migrantes," an organization formed by Haitians and Baptist churches interested in helping migrants. Using his skills and ability to speak four different languages, Moise helps migrants and migrant communities achieve their new beginnings. Deliris supports Deborah's House, a ministry for women survivors of domestic violence and their children. They strongly believe that God uses us all wherever we live, and new opportunities are open for those who trust in the Lord.
