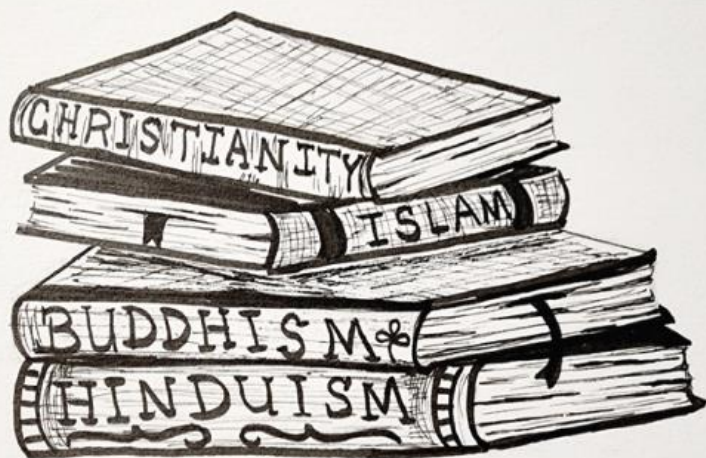

If you would like to physically volunteer to assist with storm cleanup, or know of someone who has been affected by the storm and could use volunteer assistance, contact Butch Porter, Southern Baptists in Indiana (not affiliated with Bloomfield FBC), 618-499-2215. They will match you up with a household needing assistance. If you are volunteering, remember to dress ready to work. Hard sole footwear, long pants, gloves, etc.

The Greene County Health Department in Bloomfield is offering free tetanus shots to anyone affected by the tornado or assisting in cleanup. It is recommended that those involved in cleanup have had a tetanus shot within the last 5 years. The GC health department will also assist tornado victims who have lost their birth certificate in the storm.

The following items are needed or can be picked up at the Linton First Christian Church: Extension cords, charger cords, D and C batteries, muscle pain relief cream, laundry detergent, bedding, plastic totes, gallon zip lock bags, trash bags, pillows, air mattresses, sleeping bags, tents, towels/wash cloths, dish towels/cloths, sunscreen, Gatorade, refill water bottles.
