

#### Class Offered During Wednesday Community Fellowship

We invite you to join us as we combat the loneliness epidemic. We will add verbal "relationship exercises" and continue practicing simple "balance exercises" that were taught earlier this summer. (You do not need to have attended the 8-week balance class in order to participate.) This will be an interactive class with some skill teaching but will mainly emphasize questions for discussion to help us create deeper relationships and friendships with our Christian sisters and brothers. In Charlotte's personal and therapeutic experience, we live in a society (including in churches) where people are lonely and disconnected, knowing others only on a superficial level. We will practice skills to connect more deeply spiritually and relationally. We will also focus on finding and fulfilling God's purpose and callings in our lives no matter what our age and on appreciating the gift of years. 

### Greene County Long Term Recovery Group

On May 16, a devastating tornado tore through Linton, Switz City, and Worthington in Greene County, destroying 26 properties and severely damaging 56 others. Many affected families were uninsured or underinsured and are now facing overwhelming loss. In response, the Greene County Long-Term Recovery Group (LTRG), an all-volunteer effort, was formed to help residents rebuild. With support from United Way, which is serving as a fiscal sponsor at no cost, 100 % of donations will go directly to victims. The group's urgent goal is to provide \$1,000 in aid to at least 25 families. FEMA assistance does not cover this disaster, so local support is critical. Donations can be made through:
