2025 FBC Annual Congregational Meeting Notice

Please plan to attend the Congregational Meeting scheduled for 6:30 p.m. on Thursday, November 13th in the FBC sanctuary. There are several issues to vote on (see agenda below). To vote on any requires a quorum of at least 20 members to be present. To be eligible to vote, you must be a member of FBC and at least 16 years of age. The following is the agenda for the meeting:

1. Vote to approve minutes of the November 14, 2024 congregational meeting
2. Committee reports (no vote required)
3. Vote to approve the slate of FBC officers for 2026 (closed ballot)
4. Presentation of 2026 deacons
5. Vote to approve the proposed amount designated non-taxable for the FBC parsonage
6. Vote to approve proposed revisions to the FBC Constitution and the Personnel, Policies, and Procedures Handbook
7. Approval of the 2026 FBC Budget (closed ballot)
