Sunday evening, June 7, at 6 p.m. in the sanctuary, Nathan will lead this conversation. All are welcome!

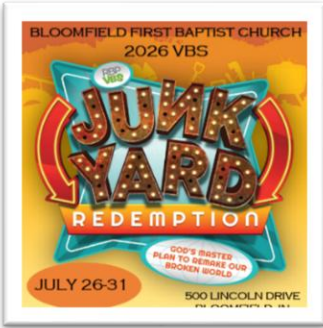
“Conversations” Evangelism Training Saturday, June 13
